- Q. Does this area look familiar to you?
- A. As far as the canal, the sidewalk, the road and railroad goes, yes, but to the location of the houses no.

JA: Ask him directly if he is able to point out the location of the house?

- Q. You say you are familiar with the road, canal, railroad track and all that; are you familiar or are you able to point out one of those houses as the one you have been there?
- A. No.
- Q. Do you know the number of the house where you entered that day?
- A. I went back there afterwards and identified the house having the number "88" as being the house where the arrest was made.
- Q. Do you know the name of the street?
- A. I could not say.

CROSS-EXAMINED BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER

- Q. When you first saw the vehicle that you said was backed up to the canal were it's wheels overhanging to such an extent it could not be driven away?

A. I don't know much about the mechanics, the disposition of the wheels on a 60 cwt but I know that it would have been impossible to leave on his rear wheels.
- Q. Why?
- A. The wheels were not touching the pavement.
- Q. When you first saw Brisson that day you said an officer was with him, who was the officer?
- A. I don't remember the name of the officer, I was only arrived to the Regiment.
