

Dear Sirs:

Further to my letter of the 13th instant re Chemainus I.R. #13 Timber Licence No. 266, I now wish to advise that it is apparent that the total area of the South part of the Reserve surrendered by the Indians is 1612 acres instead of the 1800 acres thought to be the area. This will mean that you are rightfully responsible for the dues covering ground rent up to the 1612 acres.

Kindly advise, by return mail, if you will be prepared to pay this ground rental of 20¢ per acre, on the area mentioned, so that it may be included in the Licence.
