

...SKWAH.....INDIAN RESERVE

We, the undersigned Chief and Councillors of the Skwah Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at Chilliwack, in the New Westminster Indian Agency, in the Province of British Columbia at a council summons for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this Seventh day of July, A.D. 1953, in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Citizenship and Immigration for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian Owners of the said Reserve, request that William Mussell, No. 66 of the Skwah Band, BE AND IS HEREBY LOCATED to the following parcels of land on Skwah I. R. No. 4, more particularly described as follows: -

- (1) Commencing at a point being N 63° 33' 94.2 feet from the intersection of Landing road and Barritt road; thence N 80° 00' W 203 feet thus establishing the North-East Corner of property concerned; thence N 80° 00' W 633 feet; thence S 3° 20' E 744 feet; thence N 86° 30' E 631 feet; thence N 4° 25' W 592 feet to point of commencement and containing therein 9.47 acres more or less of cleared land.
- (2) Commencing at a point being N 63° 33' W 94.22 feet from the intersection of Landing road and Barritt road; thence N 80° 00' W 1305 feet thus establishing the North-East Corner of property concerned; thence N 80° 00' W 180 feet; thence S 80° 00' W 70 feet; thence S 3° 30' E 1130 feet; thence approx S 90° 00' E 270 feet; thence N 3° 30' W 1110 feet to point of commencement and containing therein 6.8 acres more or less of cleared land.
- (3) Commencing at a point being N 63° 33' W 94.2 feet; ~~thence~~ from the intersection of Landing road and Barritt road; thence N 80° 00' W 235 feet thus establishing the South-East Corner of property concerned; thence N 80° 00' W 1300 feet; thence North-Westerly approximately 1280 feet along South bank of Hope slough; thence South approx 460 feet to point of commencement and containing therein 6.5 acres more or less of cleared land.
