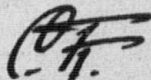

With regard to the issue of the temporary Licence or Certificate of Airworthiness you are advised that according to our records Mr. Quinlan was given authority to operate CF-EGG as a commercial aircraft until April 29th, 1949 and that this authority was subsequently renewed until June 17th, 1949. Mr. Grant will be able to confirm this and other details on his arrival in Haileybury.
