

(5). REGULAR MEMBERS shall be persons eighteen years of age, and upwards, who on their election pay to the Recording Secretary an entrance fee of three dollars, and thereafter pay dues as provided for by Article IV of this Constitution. They shall have a right to take part in and vote at all meetings and gatherings of the Society.

(6). CORRESPONDING MEMBERS shall be persons residing at least ten miles from the City of St. John, who contribute by correspondence and otherwise to the work of the Society, and have been duly elected. They shall have a right to attend all meetings and gatherings, but not to take part in the business of the Society.

(7). ASSOCIATE MEMBERS shall be ladies who on their election pay to the Recording Secretary, an entrance fee of one dollar, and thereafter pay dues as provided for by Article IV of this Constitution. They shall have a right to take part in and vote at all meetings and gatherings of the Society, excepting the Annual Meeting.

(8). JUNIOR MEMBERS shall be youths of ten to eighteen years of age, who on their election pay to the Recording Secretary, an entrance fee of one dollar, and thereafter pay dues as provided for by Article IV of this Constitution.

They shall have a right to attend all meetings, but not to take part in the business of the Society.

(9). Unless otherwise provided herein, all members may be elected at any ordinary meeting of the Society, and the votes required for the election of any person to membership shall be at least three-fourths of the ballots cast by members present who are entitled to vote.

(10). Whenever any person is elected a Regular, Associate, or Junior member, the Recording Secretary shall immediately inform him of the same by letter (according to Form "B" in the Appendix) and the election of Honorary members, Benefactors, Life and Corresponding members, shall be communicated
