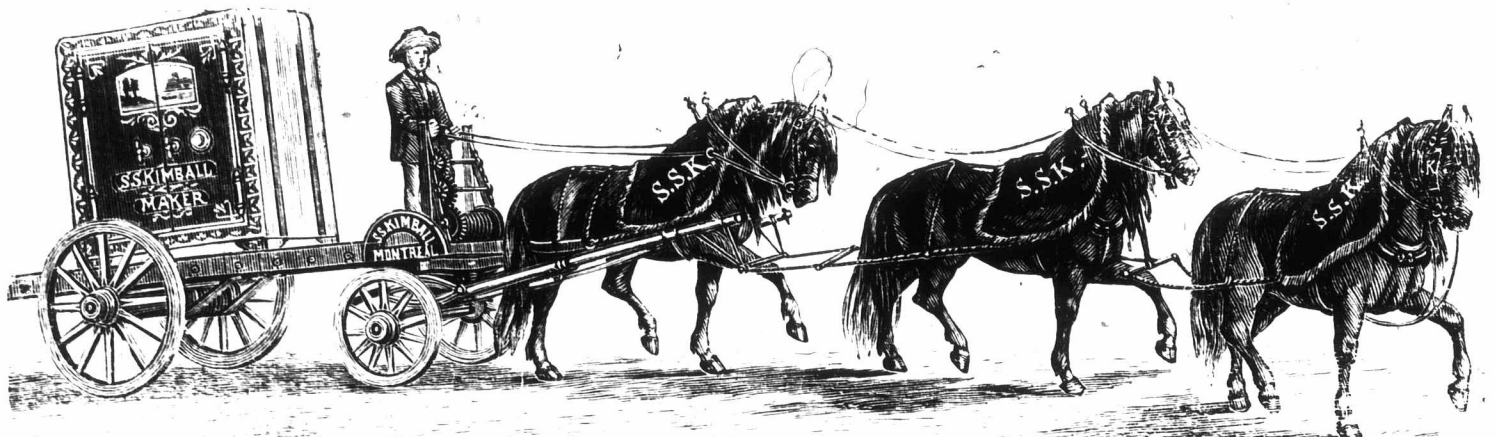
J. BARTON'S PATENT CHAMPION STUMP AND GRUB EXTRACTOR.
