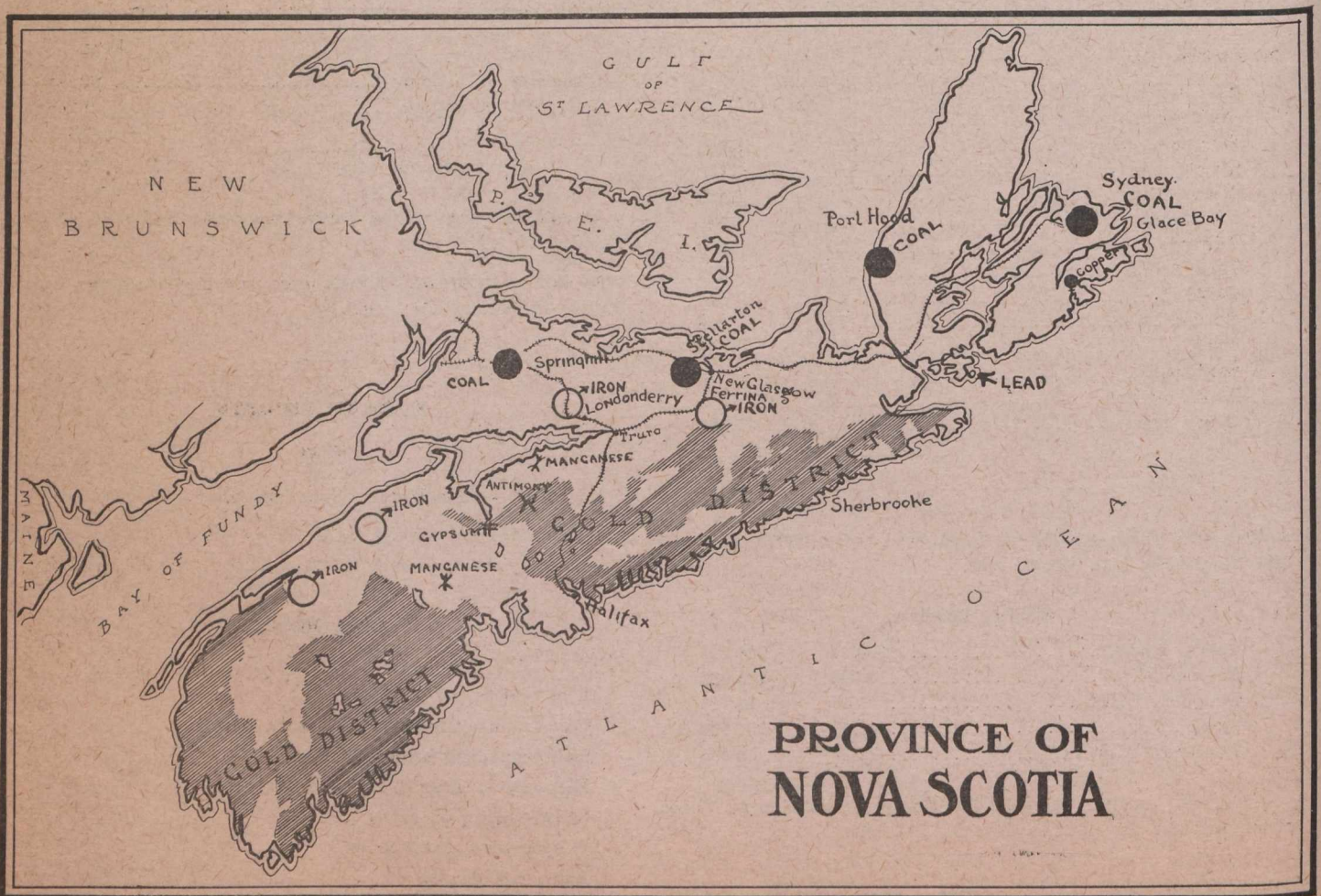
MARKET NOTES.
