## CAP. VIII.

An Act further to continue for a limited time the powers granted to certain commissioners by an act, intituled, "An Act for removing the Old "Walls and Fortifications that surround the City of Montreal and other"vise to provide for the falubrity, convenience and embeldshment of the "faid (ity;" as also to continue for a limited time the extension of the said powers in certain cases.

ATHEREAS an Act passed in the forty-second year of. His Majesty's Reign. intituted. " An Ad for removing the old walls and fortifications that furround "the City of Montreal and otherwise to provide for the funbrity, convenience and em-" bellishment of the faid City," was continued by another act passed in the fortyfifth year of the said Reign, initialed, "An Act to continue for a limited time the " powers granted to certain commissioners by an act, intituled, " An Act for re-" moving the old walls and Fortifications that furround the City of Montreal and " otherwise to provide for the falubrity, convenience and embellishment of the faid City. and for extending thep wers in certain cafes;" And which act was further continued by another act palled in the forty-eighth year of the laid Reign, intituled, "An A& " furth r to continue for a limited time the powers granted to ceitain commillioners " by an act, initialed, " An Ait for removing the old walls and fortifications that furround the City of Montreal and otherwise to provide for the falubrity, convenience " and embel firment of the faid City," as also to continue for a limited time the extension of the said powers in certain cases;" And which acts will expire at the end of the prefent session of the Provincial Parliament; And whereas the commiffiguers appointed under the first mentioned act have been prevented from carrying into full execution the powers in them vefted from various causes unavoidable on their part, such as difficulties with adjoining proprietors for exchanges. of land, necessary to give effect to their plans, and the impracticability of finding purchafers for a number of the Lots, whereof the proceeds were to be applied to pu poles under the faid acts, and also the impracticability by reason of the war, of obtaining military aid during last fuminer for lowering and extending the Champ. de Mars, which is a material part of the laid plans, yet unexecuted, and it being therefore expedient and necessary that the powers of the faid commissioners should. be further continued for a limited time; Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled. by virtue of and under the authority of an act passed in the Parliament of Great B. tain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an act passed in the sourceenth. " year of His M. lesty's Reign, inituled, " an Ast for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America," And to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that all and every of the powers of the Gover-
