NEWS OF OUR OWN LAND

Happenings of the Last Forty-Eight Hours Throughout Canada.

ANOTHER ABSCONDER'S ARREST

H. H. Henshew, a New Kewler, Arrested in Toronto for Forgery—Irregularities in Government Surveys Alleged—Burglars Captured—Other News.

TORONTO, July 31.—On Saturday Detective Sergeant C. Hestberg, New York, arrived in this city to arrest Herman H. Besocke on a charge of grand larceny in the first degree and a second charge of forgery.

Besocke was in the employ of Messrs. Hamilton H. Selmonds & Brandt, 125 Front Street, New York, as a bookkeeper. About the middle of last year he was told of last year he applied for his holiday, and asked for a day over the limit allowed him when he was alleged to have robbed the firm of \$8,000 by falsifying checks and cashing them, forging checks, and a robbery of certain moneys. He is supposed to have been driven into crime through an inordinate passion for gambling, speculating on horses, and the like. Besocke has consented to return without waiting for extradition papers, and will start for New York to-morrow with Detective Sergeant Hestberg.

ANOTHER TRIAL.

Charles Luskoy to be Tried for the Murder of His Mother and Sister.

SMITH'S FALLS, July 31.—Charles Luskoy, who was found guilty of the murder of his father several years ago, was again tried at the Fall Assizes for the murder of his mother and sister, who were murdered at the same time. Detective Greer is still at work on the case, interest in which has been revived by the statements of a man, who says that the day the Luskoy family were created he was on his way to Luskoy Creek to take the train for the States. He took a short cut across the Luskoy farm, and passed close by the house. When just inside he saw a young-looking man run from the house in pursuit of a girl, who was running away screaming at the top of her voice. A short distance from the house he says, the man overtook her, struck her down with a steel yard, and dragged her back into the house.
