OXFORD COUNCILLORS HAVE BUSY SESSION

Ingersoll Wants Renewal of Separation Agreement Between Town and County.

Woodstock, June 4.—A quiet day's business was transacted by the county council of Oxford at its opening meeting of the June session here today. The greater part of the day was occupied by the receiving of communications and reports, after which the committees met.

The outstanding features of the June session will be the striking of the year's estimates, the reception and consideration of the boundary

bridges reports, and the hearing of deputations and the annual visit of the councillors to the House of Refuge and Industrial Farm. A special committee will also be appointed to meet with a committee from the town council of Ingersoll for the making of a new separation agreement between the town and county. This agreement, which is of a five year term, expires this year, and will have to be renewed. The report of the mothers' allowance committee for the half-year showed that twenty-five mothers were receiving allowances, the cost to the county being \$840.
