real is attended with great risk and danger to the town and alarming to the inhabitants thereof, by reason of the proximity of the buildings to the harbour or usual place of unloading at the Market Gate: And whereas the landing of gunpowder from on board of ships or other vessels, and the carting thereof into the Powder Magizines may, if not carefully attended to, be productive of the most fatal effects; Be it so enacted by the Kings Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Assembly of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth, year of His Hajesty's reign, intituled an Act for making some effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provisions for the Government of the said Province."

No vessel to enter the harbour of it shall not be lawful for the master or masters of Montreal with more than five pounds of pounds.
