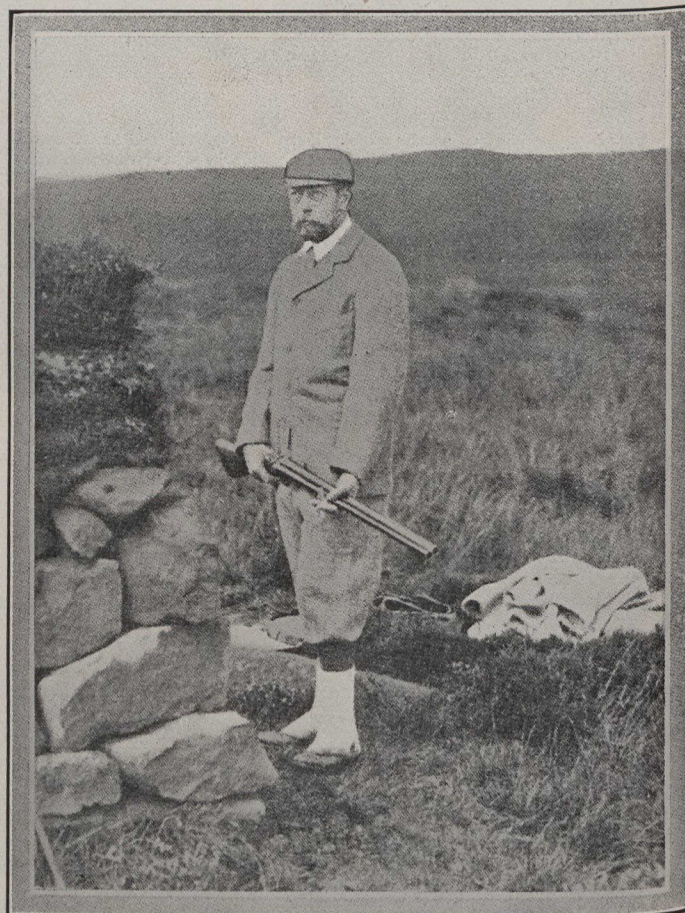


Canada's Contribution
