POLICIES, THE INVESTMENT CLIMATE AND THE VERY SERIOUS

PROBLEM OF INADEQUATE EMPLOYMENT OF OUR HUMAN RESOURCES 
ALL THESE MUST AND ARE BEING ADDRESSED ON THEIR OWN

MERITS AND IN THE CONTEXT OF TOTAL ECONOMIC POLICY.

HOWEVER, A SUCCESSFUL TRADE NEGOTIATION CAN BE AN IMPORTANT

ELEMENT IN FACILITATING ONGOING ADJUSTMENT AND IN

CONTRIBUTING TO HIGHER PRODUCTIVITY.

THIS RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN TRADE LIBERALIZATION AND OTHER ELEMENTS IN THE ECONOMIC PROCESS WAS RECOGNIZED AT THE LONDON ECONOMIC SUMMIT. NOT ONLY DID THE SUMMIT COMMUNIQUE ASSERT THAT THE MTN MUST BE PURSUED VIGOROUSLY, IT ALSO AFFIRMED THAT THE CONTINUING ECONOMIC DIFFICULTIES MADE IT EVEN MORE ESSENTIAL TO ACHIEVE THE TRADE LIBERALIZATION OBJECTIVES CONTAINED IN THE TOKYO DECLARATION. THE SUMMIT COMMUNIQUE REJECTED PROTECTIONIST TRADE POLICIES AS AN APPROACH WHICH WOULD FOSTER UNEMPLOYMENT, INCREASE INFLATION AND UNDERMINE THE WELFARE OF ALL PEOPLE. SUMMIT PARTICIPANTS COMMITTED THEMSELVES TO SEEK "TO PROMOTE SOLUTIONS THAT CREATE NEW JOBS AND CONSUMER BENEFITS THROUGH EXPANDED TRADE AND TO AVOID APPROACHES WHICH RESTRICT TRADE".

BUT EVEN IN THIS CONTEXT, IT NEEDS TO BE
CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THAT NEITHER WE NOR OUR TRADING
PARTNERS ARE PARTICIPATING IN THIS NEGOTIATION FOR ANY
