

27. The Canadian side provided information on the "Visits by Foreign Artists to Canada" exchange programme.

The Mexican side took note of this programme.

28. The two Parties will endeavour to keep each other informed regarding any activities they carry out in the Americas, so that the possibility of these activities being presented in the other country might be examined.

29. The Canadian side informed the Mexican side concerning the visit of groups of Canadian artists to Mexico for certain private presentations.

The Mexican side took note of this and expressed its interest in extending the benefits of these presentations to certain government institutions.

Canada will provide a detailed list of the groups and will convey Mexico's interest to the parties concerned.

30. Mexico is interested in receiving the following exhibitions:

- Indian art from southwestern Canada (Instituto Nacional de Antropología e Historia [National Institute of Anthropology and History] (INAH)).
- A collection of photographs and posters (Instituto Mexicano del Seguro Social [Mexican Social Security Administration] (IMSS)).
