(1) Canadian citizens who are in possession of valid national passports may without previously obtaining a visa enter the Netherlands for periods not exceeding three months.

(2) It is understood that the modification of entrance requirements does not apply to those citizens of the Netherlands and the Netherlands who are respectively in Canada and the Netherlands for the purpose of carrying out their professional, business, or other activities.

(3) The Government of the Netherlands is prepared to accept the foregoing provisions of the Canadian Government has the honour to suggest that the present agreement between the two Governments which shall take effect on the 1st of January 1950.
