## **University of Winnipeg**

A university-to-university agreement for both students and faculty of all departments. The exchange allows for up to three exchange students from either university. In 1994, two students from Bamberg studied in Winnipeg but no students from Winnipeg came to Bamberg. The students from Bamberg are selected by the "Akademisches Auslandsamt". In Winnipeg, the Office of the Dean of Arts is responsible for the selection of students.

Travel and accommodation is paid for by the participants. There is a tuition waiver for students at the partner university. Students from Winnipeg do not have to provide the regular PNDS test for foreign students and are assisted in finding accommodation in a student residence in Bamberg. In general, students remain enrolled at their home university (but with leave status), unless they decide to do otherwise. Duration of the exchange is one year.

Currently, the program is not fully used due to changes in the administration of the program in Winnipeg.
