(A) INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS AND AGREEMENTS

Agreements concluded:

1. Multilateral: Supplementary Protocol to the International Agreement for the regulation of Whaling of June 8, 1937, extending beyond March 24, 1946, the whaling season for 1945-1946. Opened for signature in London, March 15, 1946. (See Section B.5)
2. Canada-Australia: Exchange of Notes amending for the period August 13 to December 31, 1946, the Trade Agreement between the two countries of July 8, 1931, as regards duty on oranges imported in Canada. Signed at Canberra, July 19 and August 13, 1946. (See Section B.7)
3. Canada-Union of South Africa: Exchange of Notes amending for the period September 1, 1946, to March 31, 1947, the Trade Agreement between the two countries of August 20, 1932, as regards carpet wool imported into Canada. Signed at Pretoria, October 22, 1946. (See Section B.8)
4. Canada-United States of America: Exchange of Notes recording an Agreement for the waiver of claims arising from maritime collisions involving vessels of the two countries. Signed at Washington, September 28 and November 13/15, 1946.
