CANADIAN DELEGATION TO PRESIDENTIAL
INAUGURATION IN GUATEMALA

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, announced today the composition of the Canadian delegation to the inaugural ceremonies of the new President of Guatemala, His Excellency Marco Vinicio Cerezo Arévalo. The delegation will be led by Mr. Charles Henry Cook, Parliamentary Secretary to the Secretary of State for External Affairs, who will be accompanied by Senator Jean-Maurice Simard, the Canadian Ambassador to Guatemala, Mr. André Potvin and Mr. John Graham, Director General, Caribbean and Central America Bureau, Department of External Affairs.

The inaugural ceremonies of President Cerezo will take place in Guatemala City on January 14, 1986.
