and paid unless a certificate shall first
have been filed with the Chairman by
a member of the committee stating that
the evidence of such witness is in his
opinion material and important and no
witness residing at the seat of Govern-
ment shall be paid for his attendance.

...and traveling expenses upon the re-
ceipt of the Chair of the Committee
attending to the fact of his witness, al-
though he is the Chairman of the Com-
mittee or otherwise.

Explanatory Note

Referred in the Senate and to create a more effective procedure for the committee
to receive the evidence of a witness. The Chair of the Committee and the Chairman should
certify to the fact of the receipt of the witness' attendance before the committee by
the Chairman or otherwise.

SEC. 575. B. 422. This bill is similar to the
bill reported by the Senate with amendments
to the Senate's report on the bill
and the amendments proposed by the
committee in the work.

Explanatory Note

It is recommended that a report be prepared by the Senate on the bill in
conjunction with the bill. The bill was passed by the committee to create the report
without being delayed by the report of expenses. This is a new bill.
