Mr. *Burpee* (Sunbury) moved, that the following words be added to the said motion:—"and that strangers be excluded from the Refreshment Saloon of the House of Commons."

Mr. *White* (Cardwell) moved in amendment thereto, that the words: "unless accompanied by a Member" be inserted, after the words: "House of Commons"; which was agreed to.

And the question being put, on the main motion as amended, it was accordingly *Resolved*, That the Hon. the Speaker be requested to issue an Order closing the bar for the sale of Intoxicating Liquors within the precincts of this House, and that strangers be excluded from the Refreshment Saloon of the House of Commons, unless accompanied by a Member.

On motion of Mr. *Wallace* (Norfolk), an Order of The House was issued, for a copy of the Report of the Engineer who made a Survey of Wiarion Harbor.

The House then adjourned.
