67. (1) The standing committees shall be as follows:
(a) The Joint Committee on the Library of Parliament to which shall be appointed seventeen senators.
(b) The Joint Committee on the Printing of Parliament to which shall be appointed twentyone senators.
(c) The Joint Committee on the Restaurant of Parliament to which shall be appointed the Speaker and six other senators.
(d) The Joint Committee on Regulations and other Statutory Instruments to which shall be appointed eight senators.
(e) The Joint Committee on Official Languages Policy and Programs, to which shall be appointed nine senators.
(f) The Committee on Standing Rules and Orders, composed of fifteen members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, which is empowered on its own initiative to propose to the Senate amendments to the rules from time to time.
(g) The Committee on Internal Economy, Budgets and Administration, composed of fifteen members, four of whom shall constitute a quorum, which is empowered on its own initiative to consider any matter relating to the internal economy of the Senate, including budgetary matters and administration generally, and to report the result of such consideration to the Senate.
