Dear Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of August 31st with reference to the visit to McGill of the Oxford Debating Team. The Principal is at present out of the city and I do not think he will be in Montreal before the 15th of the month.

Regarding the date of the team's visit, October 19th is "Sports Day" at McGill and also the Principal expects to be in Toronto on that day, so I am afraid it would not be suitable. October 20th falls on Saturday, but I think the debate could probably be arranged for that evening. It is difficult for me to make a positive statement just now, as the officers of the Debating Society are widely scattered, but if it is impossible for the team to be in Montreal on the 18th, I think the choice will have to fall on the 20th.

With reference to Judges, I do not think there will be any difficulty regarding the McGill Committee co-operating with the Rhodes Scholarship Committee for the Province of Quebec.
