Time for construction of railway limited. 16. If the construction of the railway is not commenced, and fifteen per cent on the amount of the capital stock is not expended thereon, within three years after the passing of this Act, or if the railway is not finished and put in operation * within seven years after the passing of this Act, then the 5 powers conferred upon the Company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the railway as then remains uncompleted.
