

Article 14.

Twenty-five members of the Association shall form a quorum for the transaction of business other than altering the Constitution or By-Laws or borrowing money.

Article 15.

All members shall be entitled after admission to a Certificate of Membership, signed by the President and Secretary.

Article 16.

These By-Laws shall not be rescinded, altered or added to except by an extraordinary resolution of the Association passed at an annual or a general meeting of which written notice shall have been given to the members at least ten days prior thereto, at which meeting there shall be not less than one-tenth of the members of the Association present.

Article 17.

The Secretary shall at least ten days prior to the Annual "Round Up" or meeting or any extraordinary meeting, mail to every member a notice stating the time and place thereof, and shall set out in the notice any proposed amendments to the Constitution or By-Laws, or any proposed borrowing of any money.
