of which it is the Capital, are able to mufter forty Thousand fighting Men; Half of which Number would render our new Colony impregnable, and *Boston* itself stand as secure from Invasion, by the Interposition of a Barrier so populous and invincible.

But after all these hopeful Beginnings, if this great and beneficial Enterprize should be sufpended, by the Menaces or golden Promises of a certain crafty Power; or if it should be neglected for Want of Money, withheld to squander another Way: If (I fay) this Colony should at length prove a mere Baby of State, highly favoured and fondled in the Cradle for a young Patriot's Amusement, but afterwards forsfaken and exposed, as *Carolina* was formerly; then may we fay, with just Cause of Lamentation, that this Kingdom is fallen indeed below the Envy of its meanest Neighbours.
