CHAPTER VII.

OF THE STUDENTS ATTENDING THE HOSPITAL.

- I. The Students of regularly qualified practitioners in the city, shall be admitted by ticket signed by two members of the Medical Board, to attend at the regular visiting hour, and at no other time, except by special permission, to witness the practice of the Hospital.
- II. Every Student so admitted shall behave with decorum and propriety.
- III. Any Student who shall infringe any of the regulations of the Hospital, or be guilty of any improper conduct, shall be deprived of his ticket with its attending privileges.

CHAPTER VIII.

OF THE PATIENTS.

- I. No patient shall be admitted into the Institution until he or she shall have been examined by some member of the Medical Board, and pronounced by such officer to be a suitable person for Hospital treatment.
- II. In any urgent case, when delay may be dangerous, the House Surgeon or Physician shall have power to admit patients, and shall immediately give information to the Physician or Surgeon, as the case may be, in whose ward such patient may be placed, and if he cannot be found, to any other member of the Hospital Medical Board.
- III. No patient shall be admitted into the Hospital whose case shall be considered incurable, or who is in-
