WHEAT MOVES UP ONCE MORE

Despite Bearish Character of Statistical News.

Demand From Europe for Cash Wheat Apparently Strong Again With Higher Cables-Providing Advance All Round-American and European Visible Supply.

Caution the List to be Heavy, and With Same Exceptions Losses of From a Fraction to 1-4 Points are Recorded-Quotations and Gossip.

Monday Evening, May 16. London ended losses of 1/4 to 3/4 point in American rails to-day, and this together with the loss on the Wall-street market, led to weakness in the Wall-street market.

Canadian securities were lower to-day in sympathy. On the Toronto Board the steel and iron stocks showed a loss of 1/2 day of a fraction to 3/4.

At Montreal C.P.R. final bids were 2 1/2, Cable 2 1/2, Richelieu 2 1/2, Montreal Railway 3 1/2, and Montreal Gas 4 1/2, etc., below Friday's closing.

In the United States failures for the past week are 246 and in Canada 24, total 270, against 282 last week, 278 the preceding week and 283 the corresponding week last year.
