Times and Places of Sittings of the Several Civil and Criminal Courts.

General (Criminal) Sessions. June 12, December 11.

County Court Sittings, for trial of issues in fact—June 12, December 11.

County Court Sittings, for hearing motions, &c.—January 2, April 2, July 3, October 1,—January 7, 1884

County Court Sittings, for trial of issues in fact—*without a jury*—April 3, October 2.

Surrogate Courts —TERMS: Commence January 2, April 2, July 3, October 1,—January 7, 1884.

Judge's Chambers—Mondays and Thursdays and on other days specially appointed for High Court of Justice or other Court Chamber business.

Court of Speedy Trial, *by judge, without a jury*, in criminal cases—not being capital felonies, &c—Sittings as occasion may require after commitment of prisoner

(All the above Courts sit in the Court House, *Barrie*.)

Courts of Appeal—Assessment.—(From Courts of Revision.)—Times and places of sittings fixed by the Judge as occasion requires, between July 6th and July 31st

Courts of Appeal—Voters' Lists.—(For Revision and Correction.)—Times and places of sittings fixed by the Judge as occasion requires.
