- County Court Sittings, for trial of issues in fact-without a jury April 3, October 2.
- Surrogate Courts TERMS: Commence January 2, April 2, July 3, October 1, —January 7, 1884.
- Judge's Chambers Mondays and Thursdays and on other days specially appointed for High Court of Justice or other Court Chamber business.
- Court of Speedy Trial, by judge, without a jury, in criminal cases—not being capital felonies, &c—Sittings as occasion may require after commitment of prisoner
