Soak the fish over night. Pour off the water. Cut into small bits. Put on cold water and bring to a boil. Pour off the boiling water, once or twice, and renew with fresh boiling water. Then add an equal quantity of potato pared and cut into slices. Cook until potatoes are done. Fry some sliced onions and pork scraps until the onions are cooked. Serve the fish and potatoes in a deep dish and pour the onions over the whole.

Fancy Rolls Barred—It Will Mean a Big Saving in Sugar—No "Return" Leaves

Washington, Nov. 14.—The baking industry of the country is to be put on a war basis on December 10, under government regulation. After that date loaves of standard size only may be baked, and the industry must adopt a formula prepared by the food administration. There will be no more fancy rolls, in the making of which large quantities of sugar are used.

ly equalled. Its first effect was stupefying. London was gloomy on Tuesday. People here had been told so often, by high authorities that the war was practically won, that the truth came as a shock.

Lloyd George's friends regret parts of the phraseology. Thus the Mail, which warmly supports him, declares the premier ought peremptorily to have suppressed many passages of his speech and some of his emotional assertions were distinctly unfortunate.

The old Asquith group made preparation for tremendous attack on the premier. Asquith's speech yesterday afternoon was eagerly anticipated.

The Daily News editorially savagely attacks the premier, declaring the speech gross, as cruel, and as false as mischievous. The paper says: "It held us up to the obloquy of Europe and the world as the chief author of the misfortunes that have befallen our cause. It invited the allies to distrust us, to think ill of us, to condemn us. We who have sacrificed our blood and treasure without murmur."

"It declares Lloyd George's present movement has a sinister aim, that the premier, having made himself a political dictator at home, proposes to make himself a general dictator."

London, Nov. 15.—(Canadian Press)—The proposed new inter-allied council was the subject of discussion in the House of Commons today, when the former premier, H. H. Asquith brought the matter before the house by interrogating Premier Lloyd-George on the functions of the council.

Mr. Asquith asked the premier whether he would now state the precise functions of the inter-allied council, and in particular of its military staff, and whether it was proposed that the council have the power to interfere with and override the opinion, on a matter of strategy, of the general staff at home and the commander-in-chief in the field; whether the military staff of the inter-allied council was to have intelligence and operations departments, or other departments of their own; whether the ultimate decision as to the distribution and movement of the various armies in the field was to rest on the council or on the governments represented by it and whether opportunity would be given to discuss the proposed arrangements and the statements made in connection therewith in the premier's Paris speech.

WAS AN EVERY DAY AFFAIR

Germany Made Much of Brush Off The Flanders Coast

London, Nov. 15.—The British admiralty comments as follows on a German report of an engagement of Flanders: "On Monday some German torpedo boat destroyers came out from under the protection of their shore batteries and fired a few rounds at our patrol vessel, none of which were hit. The fire was promptly returned and the Germans immediately retired under the protection of their shore batteries, and our patrol was resumed."

"Incidents of this nature occur daily and no way interfere with the maintenance and efficiency of our patrol and they are therefore not reported."
