approval.

THAT we intend to start active logging operations as soon as conditions
in the pulp and paper industry will permit.

And I make this Solemn Declaration conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing
that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath, and by virtue of " The
Canada Evidence Act ".
