WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over if years old may homestead a quarter section (ill seem more or less) of available Dominion and in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Abserta. The applicant must appear in particular the Dominion Lands Agency of Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by sroxy may be made at any agency, on arrina conditions, by father, mother, son taughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. DUTIES.—Six months' residence upon
