OF WATERLOO COUNTY,

Held in Berlin, Ont., April 13 and 14, 1898.

The semi-annual Conference of the Mennonite Church of the County of Waterloo, was held at the above place and date in Christian Eby Meeting House. The Conference was called to order and opened with song, reading of the 12th chapter of Romans and prayer.

The addresses of the Bishops were accepted by the Preachers and Deacons.

- 1st. Moses S. Bowman was elected chairman, to preserve order, see that no two brethren speak at the same time, to see that all business is transacted in rotation and to bring all topics to a vote before the Conference according to 1. Pet. 2: 13.
- 2nd. Resolved, that it be the unanimous advice of this Conference to the brethren and sisters, to refrain from having their likenesses taken. Sol. 14, 15, 16.
- 3rd. Resolved, that the petition of the brethren and sisters, as well as others, of Glenallan, to have this body serve them with the Word of God every four weeks, be granted. Acts 16, 9, 10.
- 4th. Resolved, that Bros. Noah Stauffer and Joseph Nahtgang serve the meeting at Glenallan every four weeks during the ensuing year. Math. 28: 10, 20.
 - 5th. Resolved to elect a Deacon for the Conestogo District. Acts 6: 1-8.

SECOND SESSION.

On Friday, April 14, the Conference was again called to order and the meeting opened with song, a short exhortation and prayer.

6th. Resolved, that we use our influence, and advise all brethren and sisters not to visit the World's Exhibition at Chicago, according to the Word of God in 1. John 2: 15, 16, 17; John 18: 36; 1. John 3: 1, 2, 3; Math. 5: 14; Phil. 2: 15.

7th. Resolved, that the programme arranged by the Sabbath School Committee be taken up and disposed of on Whit-monday, May 22nd.
