CARTERS CLAIM THEY WERE TRICKED

Montreal Strikers Are Desper ate and Intimate Serious Things Today.

Montreal, April 28.—Claiming that they have been tricked by the masters and rendered desperate by hunger, a determined handful of carters, some six or seven hundred in number, waited until nearly midnight tonight to hear the result of a meeting of the master carters at the Windsor Hotel here. No report was forthcoming, and the men decided to picket the city tomorrow and make the strike as general as it was last week when business was nearly brought to a stand still.

The trouble arose when the men reported for work this morning, and were informed that there was no agreement covering a nine hour day, and that they were liberty to return to work under conditions prevalent before the strike.
