

Person's desiring to tender are requested to register their names and addresses with the Secretary of The War Purchasing Commission, Booth Building, Otta-wa, stating the class of goods in which they are interested, whether new or second-hand or both.

Tender forms with full details of the goods and places at which samples may be seen, will be mailed when ready to those who have registered as requested above.

## Special Terms To Hospitals, Etc.

Dominion, Provincial, and Municipal departments, hospitals, chari-table, philanthropic, and similar institutions which are conducted for the benefit of the public and not for profit may purchase goods without tender at prices established by the War Purchasing Commission.

Returned Soldiers and Sailors and Widows and Dependents of Sol-diers and Sailors killed in the War may obtain supplies, for their own personal use and not for re-sale, through the nearest branch of the Great War Veterans' Association who will combine individual orders and for-ward to the War Purchasing Commission through the Dominion Com-mand of the Great War Veterans' Association. These services are ren-dered by the Great War Veterans' Association to all parties in the classes named, whether members of the Great War Veterans' Association or not.

All communications should be addressed to the Secretary, War Purchasing Commission, Booth Building, Ottawa, who will be glad to supply lists and fur-ther details to those interested.
