Gardening on a Thirty-Foot Lot—Amateur Tells How He "SOUEALED" ON BY Raised Many Vegetables-When to Sow Seed and How to Avoid Pests-Constant Vigilance is the Price of Success-Points as to Hotbeds, Spring Planting, Etc.

An exceedingly practical paper on "Vegetable Production on a Thirty-foot Lot" was read by Mr. George Baldwin before the Ontario Horticultural Society. Mr. Boldwin is an amateur gardener living on Dovercourt road in this city, and his advice was based on much happy experience. He said it part:

The happier life, in my opinion, is that which is fullest with the most agreeable occupation. Now, if gardening be considered as an amusement, as a game in which your neighbors and competitors are striving to win, it becomes truly delightful and gives such results in return for the energy you put into it.

Gardening should be regarded, as I have already intimated, as a game which is played from the love of it, rather than from necessity.

Onion Culture.
