FERGUSON, GEORGE. (Cariboo.)

B. in Cumberland, Eng. Elected for Cariboo, Oct. 1879, in the place of the late member, Mr. John Evans, who died a few weeks previously. A Conservative.—Cariboo.

GALBRAITH, R. T. (Kootenay.)

First returned to Legislature at last g.e. A Conservative — Kootenay.
