

An Act to vest a certain Road Allowance in the Township of Whitby, in John W. Gamble, Esquire.

WHEREAS John W. Gamble of the Township of Vaughan, Esquire, has prayed that a certain Road Allowance upon his property in the Township of Whitby, be granted to him in lieu of other roads laid out and opened by him thereon; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

5 I. So much of the original allowance for road between Lots numbers twelve and thirteen in the third Concession of the Township of Whitby, as lies north of the said third Concession line for a distance of seventy chains, shall be and the same is hereby vested in the said John W. Gamble, his heirs and assigns for ever. The said Road allowance vested in J. W. Gamble.

10 II. The said roads so laid out and opened by the said John W. Gamble, shall be and the same are hereby declared to be public highways. Roads opened by him to be highways.

III. This Act shall be deemed a public Act. Public Act.
