An Act to amend the Provincial Statute 25th George Third, Chapter two.

HEREAS it is expedient and just that the law authorizing Sheriffs Preamble. in Lower Canada to charge and retain (over and above disbursments) a commission of two and a half per cent out of monies levied by them on writs of execution, should be repealed:—Be it therefore enacted 5 &c., as follows:

So much of the 35th Section of the Judicature Ordniance of Lower Sheriff not to Canada, passed in the twenty-fifth year of the Reign of King George the charge pound-third, Chapter two, or of any law in force in this Province, as authorizes Sheriffs on every execution to charge a commission of two and a half per 10 cent to be deducted out of the monies levied, shall be and is hereby repealed.
