An Act to consolidate and to reduce into one Act the several Laws now in force, regulating the system and practice of certain Courts in Upper Canada, established for the recovery of Small Debts, and to make other provisions therefor

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to consolidate and reduce into one Act the several laws now in force regulating the system and practice of certain Courts in Upper Canada established for the recovery of Small Debts, and to make other provisions therefor: Be it therefore enacted, &c. Preamble.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Act passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to repeal the laws now in force in that part of this Province formerly Upper Canada, for the recovery of Small Debts, and to make other provisions therefor,*"—and the Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to amend an Act passed in the fourth and fifth years of the Reign of Her Majesty, intituled, 'An Act to repeal the laws now in force in that part of this Province, formerly Upper Canada, for the recovery of Small Debts, and to make other provisions therefor,'*"—shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
