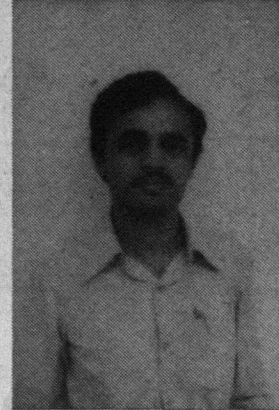
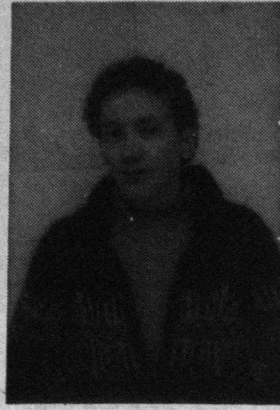
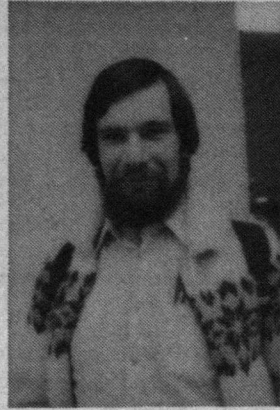
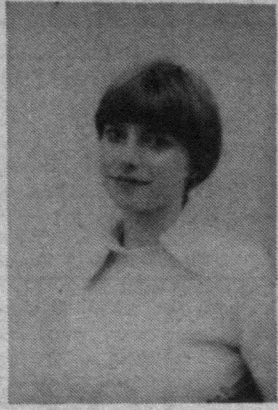


# The Student Voice

## Is 2 months' salary too much to spend for something that lasts forever?



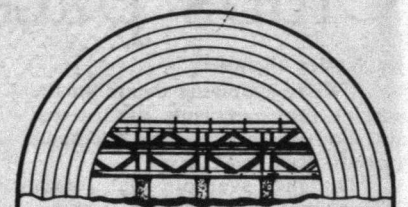
