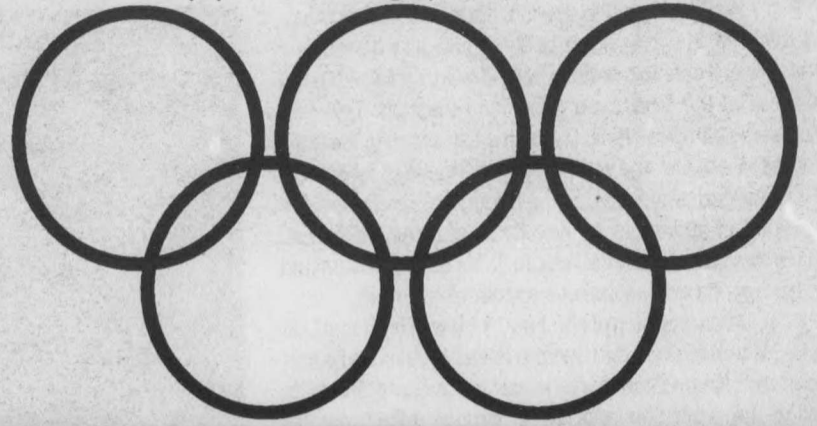

Personalized computer printed pre-registration forms will be available at your faculty where instructions are available on how to pre-register.

For all required courses campus wide and electives within the student's faculty, the schedule is as follows:

Wednesday, March 25, 1992	All Others

For all electives outside a student's faculty, pre-registration is on Monday and Tuesday, March 30 & 31, 1992.

No pre-registration will be allowed after March 31, 1992
