Replying to your letter of the 3rd instant advising us that the Indians have refused to assent to a transfer of a portion of Mount McKay at the present time, the area applied for by our clients consists of about 100 acres of the table land and about 10 acres bordering on Loch Lomond with a right of way extending from Mount McKay to Loch Lomond. We would ask you to kindly file the application notwithstanding the present dissent of the Indians to surrender, so that should a surrender be permitted later, the application of our clients will be on file and considered by the Department in case a sale is to be made.
