been sworn, declared that he never told such a thing to packson, but that on the 10th fully about 2 o'clock fr. on. being in the old Grand Irunk Depot, Lefart had given him some liquor to drink, he did not Know what Kind it was but it had considerably excited him. The Constable in rebuttal establish ed by two witnesses that he was not at that place at the hour mentioned. Onarakete heing recalled by the Judge, serve that he got the liquer some time later in the afternaon; that the Constable had called him into the Depot and had iven him some liquer to drink; that at time no one
