Ottawa, 5th October, 1906.

Edouard Moreau, an Indian of Escoumains, has reported to the Department that there is a culvert on the reserve which is high and dangerous for children, and is useless for the purpose of conducting water. He states that this culvert should be covered to avoid accidents to children.

When next you visit the reserve, kindly look into this matter, and, if necessary, direct the Indian Council to take such action in connection with the culvert as may be advisable. No expense is to be incurred, as this work should be done by statute labour.
