The Informer supplied after completion of new schedule alteration made 7/4/28

Re Boston Bay I.R. No 27 (Kopchitchin)

In my new schedule of Indian Reserves made in the Indian Agency I find the following: -

Taswiny 1928, Plan No. 787		307
Right of way C.P.R.	45.40	EX'D

after an examination of West Office Prods File 23165-272 relative to this reserve, I find that that ~~area~~ a road 38 feet in width adjacent to the railway was surveyed and a plan was filed and recorded in this office as No. Rd. 1725-24. This roadway comprised 5.66 acres; in January 1930 a provincial order in council cancelled this roadway. The same file shows that a roadway ~~plan~~ was filed with us and recorded as No. Rd. 2717. It contains one parcel of 1.72 acres west of the C.P.R. and another parcel of 3.08 east of the railway, a total of 4.80 acres. Dominion Order in Council P.C. 8392 transferred these parcels to the Province of British Columbia. It would appear that the schedule should be amended to read: -
