Sir,

With reference to instructions already given; I beg to impress upon you that it is desired to strictly enforce the regulations regarding the non-receipt of flour which is not in sacks of 100^{lbs.} each.

It is not a question simply of receipting for only the correct number of pounds of flour, but no receipt must be signed until each sack weighing less than the standard shall have been filled until it weighs 100^{lbs.}
