- Q.233 When you were in the hallway when you were going out with Bdr. Waterfield, what happened then. Did you get away from him?
- A. I don't remember. I remember just when they brought me to the Guard Room.
- Q.234 In the kitchen what happened? You remember your scuffle with Cpl. Richmond. Do you remember anything after that?
- A. Only when they came into the ration room. Bdr.
 Waterfield was in the door. I knew he was a boxer
 and thought he would punch me. I lost my head and
 don't know what happened after that.
- Q.235 This ides that you got about a "bad party". How did you come to think of that?
- A. When you are inthe Bty and two or three are against you, you haven't got a chance. I was afraid they would give me a party.
- Q.236 What gave you that idea?
- A. I don't know. Because he was a boxer and might try something at me.
- Q.237 What did Bdr. Daniels do?
- A. I don't remember what he did.
- Q.238 How many drinks had you had in the Canteen?
- A. About five or six glasses.

In the opinion of the Court it is not necessary to comply with R.P. 83(B).

The witness resumes his seat.

The defence has no further witnesses.

The defence is closed.
