### WESTBOURNE.

Is in the extreme north west of the Province. It is traversed by White Mud River (Rivière Blanche), a beautiful stream of pure water, but named White Mud by the old settlers from a kind of chalk or white clay, found in the vicinity of the lake, with which the natives were accustomed to plaster their houses. The river is well supplied with fish and is navigable for lake steamers for about six miles. Pine Creek, Squirrel Creek, Rat Creek, Big Grass River, etc., afford fine facilities for good water. Population about 1000. Number of voters 426.

### TOWNSHIP 12, RANGE VIII, WEST.

A fine settlement situated between the Assiniboine River and Lake Manitoba. Some of the farms are the largest in the Province. Has a Post Office.
