Part of Woodstock and Prince William;

Passing of this Act, that Portion of the Town or Parish of Woodstock within the said County of York, and that Part of the Parish of Prince William which hes between the said Portion of the Parish of Woodstock and the lower Lines of Lots Numbers One hundred and forty three and One hundred and forty four, as described in the Prince William Grant, and which bound the upper Line of the Glebe thereto adjoining and reserved in the said Grant, be crected into a separate and distinct Parish, and that the same shall be called, known and distinguished by the Name of Dumfries; and that Portion of the said Town or Parish of Northampton, within the said County of York, shall be called, known and distinguished by the Name of Southampton; any Law, Usage or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
